## NAMS SUBMISSION CATEGORIES & DEFINITIONS

- *Competitive Full-Length Papers* make up the core of the conference program and are organized into concurrent sessions, each of which constitutes three to four papers.
- *Research-in-Progress Papers and Abstracts* may be submitted as papers or as extended abstracts describing an ongoing research project or study of interest.
- *Case Studies* in management present summaries or syntheses of real-life management situations based on data and research requiring the reader to think through the key issues involved against both theory and the larger environment and identify appropriate strategies for the resolution of case situation.
- *Symposia/Panels* consist of a chairperson/moderator and three to five presenters offering their perspectives of the panel topic, providing the opportunity for audience participation and discussion.

## NAMS SPECIAL CONFERENCE FEATURES AND AWARDS

- *NAMS Track Awards* - one award is given for the best submission in each of the NAMS conference tracks. Each author of the chosen work will be recognized. Awards are determined by the referees from a double-blind review. The papers selected for each NAMS track award will become eligible for publication in the *Journal of the North American Management Society*.
- *MBAA McGraw-Hill/Irwin Award* - The NAMS track award winners will additionally be considered for the McGraw-Hill/Irwin Award, which is an MBAA Conference level award determined by MBAA representatives.
- *NAMS Best Student Submission Award* – Pending the reviews, one student paper will be selected by the referees for the NAMS Best Student Submission Award. Each author will be recognized. This paper will be eligible for publication in the *Journal of the North American Management Society*.

## NAMS SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

- Submissions should be uploaded as a PDF document at <https://new.precisionconference.com/mbaa>. Corresponding author(s) information will also be collected on this form.
- Submissions should be anonymized and should not exceed twelve (12) double-spaced pages nor have been presented elsewhere before the 2024 NAMS Meeting or be under consideration by other conferences or journals.

All accepted papers and symposia will be published in the *2024 Proceedings of the North American Management Society*. A condition of acceptance is that the author(s) or symposia participants must register for the conference and at least one author must attend the meetings in Chicago to present the paper. Deadline for submissions is **Monday, January 15, 2024**.
